BOOKING INFORMATION

Below are some of the common questions we get asked about booking, but there's loads more info on the Terms and Conditions page on our website. If you have further questions, you can also pick up a printed copy at our Box Office.

Our Box Office is open 10am to 3pm, Monday to Saturday and outside of this we are open again 90 minutes before any show.

All bookings are subject to a £2 transaction fee (correct at time of printing).

Ticketing options include either a digital E-ticket which can be shown on your phone at the Theatre, or they can be posted for a fee of £2, or you can collect tickets from the box office free of charge.

Refunds are only available if a show is completely cancelled. We do however offer exchanges for another show, or a credit for a fee of £1 per ticket for prices up to £15, and £3 per ticket for tickets priced at £15 and over up to seven days before the date and time of the show, this excludes Chelmsford Theatre Premium members.

Where a family ticket is offered, it comprises of the equivalent of four people, either two adults and two children or one adult and three children.

If concession tickets are available for a show they apply to under 18s, over 65s and those receiving income benefits like Disability Living Allowance and Job Seekers Allowance. You may be required to show proof of any of the above at the door.

Where children under two years of age do not require a ticket a ticket, they may accompany an adult free of charge but must sit on a lap.
